


When I finish my work, my teacher will check my answers.

Some of my answers are not correct.



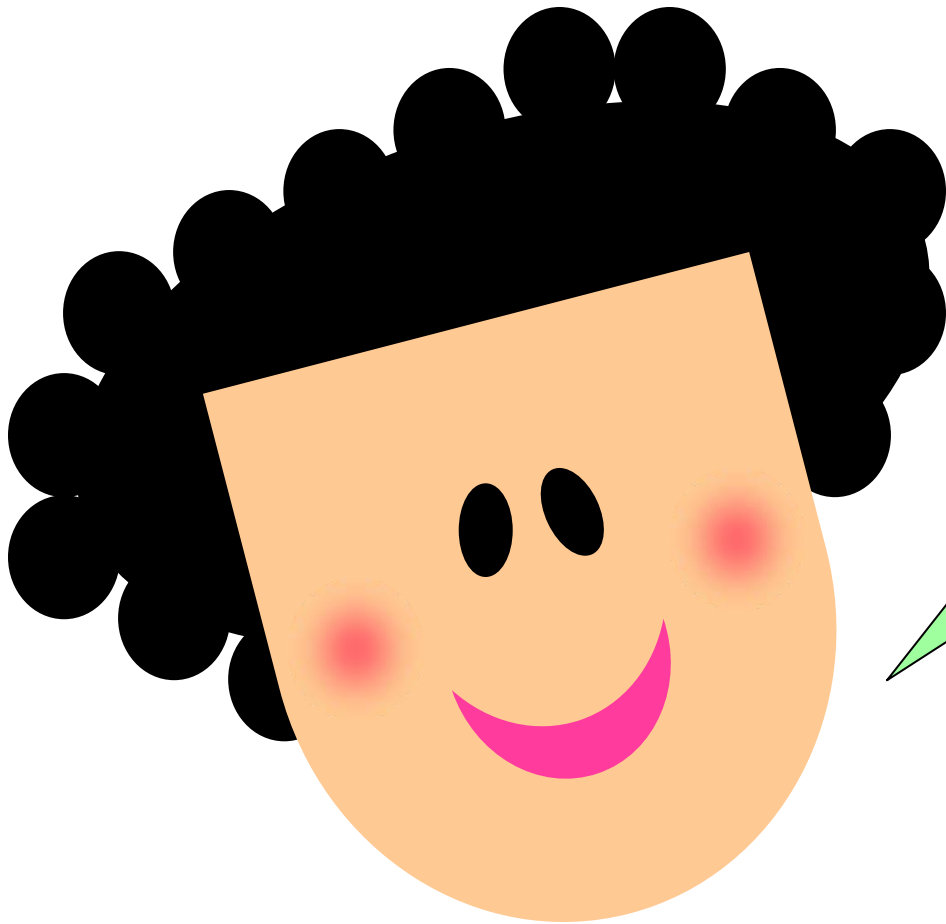

I can erase the mistake and try again.

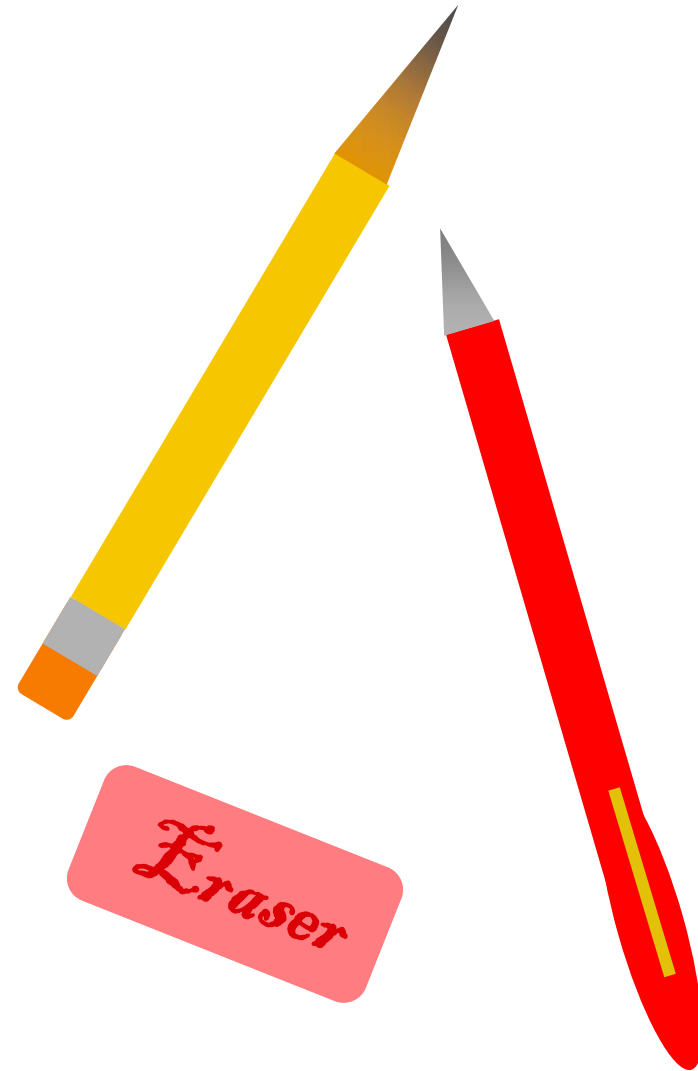
